An ENGLISH Education, a BILINGUAL Future

**Do you know a child who meets the following criteria?
If so, they could be eligible to attend an English school!**

1. The child has received the major part of their elementary or secondary school instruction in English in Canada (including French Immersion in English schools).
2. The child's siblings have received the major part of their elementary or secondary school instruction in English in Canada (including French Immersion in English schools).
3. One of the child's **parents is a Canadian citizen** and completed the majority of their elementary and/or secondary studies in English in Canada.
4. One of the child's **grandparents, aunts or uncles** is a Canadian citizen and did the majority of their elementary studies in English in Canada, and one of the child's parents received their education in French in Québec after August 26, 1977, and could have been declared eligible for instruction in English at that time.
5. One of the child's parents is on a **work permit** or a **study permit**.
6. One of the child's parents is a member of the **Canadian Armed Forces** who is posted in Québec.
7. One of the child's parents comes from another Canadian province to **work or study temporarily**.
8. One of the child's parents is in Québec on a **diplomatic status**.
9. The child has **serious learning disabilities** as defined in the government regulation adopted pursuant to section 81 of the Charter.
10. The child or siblings have received at least **three years** (majority) of elementary education in a **non-subsidized English private school**.
