The Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board Appoints Interim Director General

Rosemère, January 5, 2016 – The Council of Commissioners of the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board (SWLSB) appointed Frédéric Greschner as Interim Director General. This nomination was confirmed by a unanimous decision of the Council of Commissioners, following the resignation of the Director General, Ms. Stephanie Vucko. He will remain in the post until a permanent successor is selected through a recruitment process in the coming weeks.

Mr. Greschner occupied the position of Assistant Director General, which will be held in the interim by Gaëlle Absolonne. Ms. Absolonne remains Director of School Organization and Transportation during this transition period.

The Council is confident that both Mr. Greschner and Ms. Absolonne will provide positive leadership for the SWLSB. Jennifer Maccarone, Chairperson stated "We are fortunate to have Fred and Gaëlle serve as our interim DG and ADG, and we look forward to continuing to work with them as we focus on student success and growth."

The Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board offers educational services to more than 13,000 students in 35 schools and 5 Adult Education and Vocational Training centres and has a workforce of nearly 2000 employees.
