Dear SWLSB Parents/Guardians and Employees,

Today, Premier Legault announced that school/centre reopenings, scheduled for May 19, will be delayed until May 25. In addition to this news, public health authorities confirmed that the reopening of schools in the Joliette MRC will also be postponed. As such, **Joliette Elementary School will reopen on Monday, May 25**, with all other schools in the Greater Montreal area. For the list of schools and their opening date, see the next page.
