The Régie de police Thérèse-De Blainville wishes to inform the population that no kidnapping attempt took place in Rosemere on February 12, 2013.

On February 13, 2013, as a preventive measure, we sent a communiqué to all the schools in Rosemere to make children, parents and employees aware of the fact that a lady had approached a young girl who thought that she was being a victim of a criminal act. This communiqué was also published in social media. However, we can now confirm that no criminal offense was committed.

By the end of the day on February 13, the investigators met a mother who came to explain to the police that it had been a misunderstanding and that her actions had been wrongly interpreted by the student. In fact, worrying about her own children because she thought that she had missed the arrival of their bus, the lady questioned the young girl. By trying to ask her questions, the lady unwillingly scared the young girl who ran home to alert the police.

Upon receiving this call, police officers actively worked on this file by launching an investigation and carrying out targeted patrols. More specifically, preventive patrols around the schools in Rosemere and Willowtree Street were intensified.
