Canada's Outstanding Principals recognizes outstanding contributions of principals in publicly funded schools. It honours principals from every province and territory in Canada who have demonstrated innovation, entrepreneurial spirit and who have done something truly remarkable in public education. It is both a nationally recognized award and an Executive Leadership Training Program.
