NOTICE OF ELECTION School Elections: November 2, 2014

PUBLIC NOTICE, as per section 38 of the Act Respecting Elections, is hereby given to all eligible electors domiciled within the jurisdiction of the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board by Linda Di Domenico, Returning Officer, that:

1. All nine (9) electoral divisions are open for nomination for the positions of commissioners as well as the position of chair person.
2. Nominations for the office of School Commissioner and Chairperson will be received by the Returning Officer from Monday to Friday **2014-09-23 to 2014-09-28** between **9:00 and 12:00 hours and 13:00 to 16:30 hours**. This office will also be opened to receive declarations of candidacy on **Saturday, September 27th and Sunday, September 28th from 13:00 to 17:00 hours**. The Returning Officer is located at the Administrative Centre of the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board, 235 montée Lesage, Rosemère (Québec). **NOTE:** Candidates may obtain nomination papers from the Returning Officer at the Administrative Centre or on the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board website.
3. Any **ELIGIBLE** person can be a candidate. To be eligible the candidates must be 18 years of age, a Canadian citizen, eligible to be on the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board electoral list, be domiciled in the territory of the school board for six (6) months or more; and not be legally disqualified.

A candidate for commissioner shall only be eligible for one electoral division of the school municipality, but for the electoral division of his/her choice. Each nomination must include the name, date of birth, address, electoral division for which he/she is a candidate. The nomination must be signed by the candidate and by **ten (10) eligible electors of the electoral division, who must sign the nomination paper with their names and addresses as they appear on the electoral list**. Candidates intending to run for position of Chairperson must provide the above mentioned and obtain **fifty (50) signatures from eligible electors on the Sir Wilfrid Laurie School Board territory**.

The nomination paper of a candidate running on a recognized ticket must indicate that this candidate is a member of the ticket. The nomination paper must also be accompanied by a letter signed by the leader of the ticket certifying that the person is its official candidate for the electoral division concerned.

4. If two or more candidates are nominated for an electoral division an **advance poll** will be held on **2014-10-26 from 12:00 to 20:00 hours** and a **poll** will be held on **2014-11-02 between 10:00 and 20:00 hours**.

Any elector who does not have a child admitted to the educational services provided by one of the following school boards: Sir Wilfrid Laurier, des Affluents, des Laurentides, de Laval, Pierre-Neveu, de la Rivière-du-Nord, des Samares, et de la Seigneurie-des-Milles-Îles; may choose to exercise his/her right to vote in either the English or the French language school board. The notice of choice must be made in writing to the Returning Officer of the appropriate school board between 2014-10-04 and 2014-10-18.
