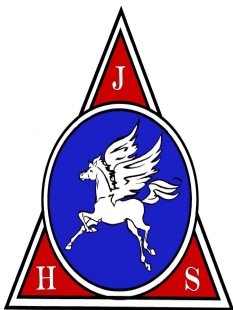

- Physical Education= 2 Credits
- Ethics= 2 Credits
- Arts= 2 Credits
- Pop= 2 Credits or 4 Credits

Requirements for obtaining a Quebec High School Secondary Diploma

- ⇒ 54 credits minimum total Secondary IV and V with 20 of these credits that must be earned in secondary V

And the following courses must be achieved:

- ⇒ Secondary V French
- ⇒ Secondary IV Mathematics
- ⇒ Secondary IV Science Applied or General
 - ⇒ Secondary IV History
 - ⇒ Secondary IV Art or Drama
- ⇒ Secondary V Ethics or Physical Education
