


#### **School Fees**

- School fees can be mailed to the school or you can pay Mary Frangiosa, the school secretary.
- School fees vary depending on course selection.
- Parents with a child in a concentration program must settle their account <u>before</u> school begins.
- Concentration fees are:
   \$150.00 for Art or Music
   \$250.00 for Soccer, Hockey, Football & Atoms.
- Cheques should be made payable to <u>Laval Junior</u> <u>High School</u> or <u>SWLSB</u>.

#### **OPUS Cards - STL**

- Representatives from the STL are here for you today.
- Any questions you might have about bus routes, pick up and drop off times, cost, transportation policy etc. etc. will be answered in the library.
- You will be able to pay for and receive your child's new OPUS card today.



## Cafeteria/Lunch



- \$3.65 for a full meal
  - This includes a hot meal, juice, soup, salad, and dessert.
- Meal cards can be purchased with 10 prepaid meals.
- We are not a nut free school.

#### Absences, Lates

- For absences parents must call the school, preferably before 7 am, to report a child's absence.
- If your child will be late, call the school or write a note. Any unjustified first period late will result in an after school detention served the next school day.
- If your child needs to sign out, send a note or call the school in the a.m. Students are not permitted to leave the school without prior parental authorization.
- Attendance is taken every period and if a student is not in class we immediately call a parent.


## **Dress Code**

#### **TOP:** Solid White, Solid Red or Solid Black

 Cardigans, sweaters, hoodies etc. must be in solid school colors (red, black or white).

#### **Bottom: Solid Black (no stripes)**

 Pants, skirts, Bermuda shorts, Capri pants, jeans, track pants



# NOTE: The following will not be permitted

- Hats and caps worn indoors
- Low cut tops
- Bare back tops□
- Bare midriff
- Sleeveless tops/Spaghetti strap camisoles
- Short shorts
- Short skirts
- Visible undergarments
- Leggings/tights
- Torn or ripped clothing
- Vulgar, racial or political slurs on clothing
- Writing/logos larger than palm size
- Outdoor wear (coats, jackets, gloves, boots in the classroom)
- Transparent clothing
- Scarves (unless for religious reasons)
- Clothes need to be sized to fit, not oversized or undersized
- Pants worn below the waist level
- Blue Jeans
- Rubber bands tied at waist behind one's back

## <u>DCV</u> (Dress Code Violation)

- Students found out of dress code:
- will be seen by school administrator,
- will be assigned a detention to be served the next school day
- may be required to change into clothing provided by administration
- parents will be advised
- Repeat offenders may serve an in-school suspension or be sent home to change.

#### **GYM CLASSES:**

- A solid red t-shirt and black shorts is required.
- Secondary 1 students have already purchased these through their school fees.
- Students are required to change their clothes for their physical education classes for reasons of hygiene and movement.
- An extra combination lock for the gym locker is required.
- Don't bring valuables to gym class.
- Goggles are required for some activities in physical education classes; <u>They are included in the school fees.</u>




