## COURSE CONTENT AND/OR GENERAL PROGRAMME OBJECTIVES

To expand and diversify the learning acquired in previous grades. To further enrich and develop students' own themes through the elements and principles of visual language as a means of representation, expression and communication. To focus on the transformation of material s using techniques from both the artistic and the craft traditions. Students are encouraged to personalize their transforming gestures, to refine the technical quality of their productions, to develop their perceptiveness and sensitivity, and to become more autonomous in creating or appreciating artistic works and achievements.

### **SPECIFIC CONTENT AND OBJECTIVES**

An introduction to Quebec and Canadian Art History through 2- and 3- dimensional studio projects, and an historical research paper.

- -Appreciates images

#### **EVALUATION**

Evaluation will be based on two competencies:

**Competency 1: 70%** of your mark will be based on works produced for your portfolio and in your sketchbook.

Breakdown of term mark for Competency 1 is 45% art making + 25% sketchbook exercises= 70%

**Competency 2: 30%** of your mark will be based on art appreciation (research essay, oral presentation, critique, tests).
