- To be able to make a musical judgement using the various elements of music learnt in class.

Evaluations will include any/all of the following:-

- Written exercises on reading and writing music with standard notation and tabs
- Research project on musical styles
- Individual performance
- Group performance (School concert, sectional work in class)
- Participation in class marks will be deducted for non justified absences (Please see school agenda)

Expectations

Each student must:

- Follow classroom rules regarding use of equipment
- Cooperate with the teacher and other students to perform as part of an ensemble
- Be an active learner and participant both in class and in school concerts
- Practise between lessons. Students are able to practise guitar at lunch times in the music room on days 2, 5, 6 and 8.
