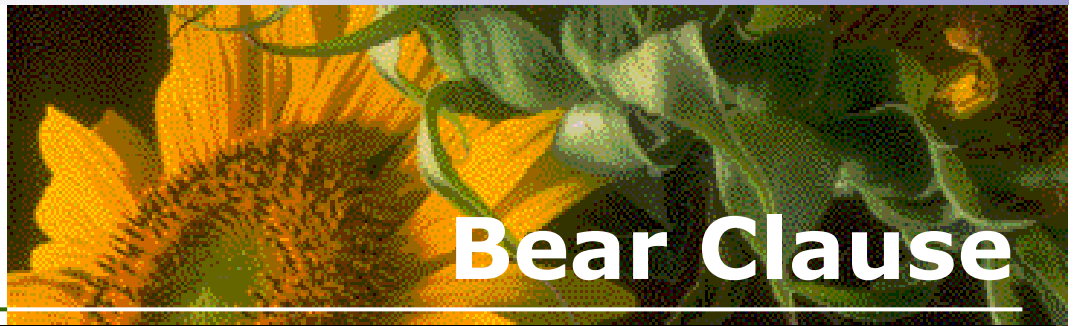

- Clarification on report cards: Information regarding credits is now indicated on the reports. An * indicates that the student is at risk, a **O** indicates that the credit is obtained and a **B** indicates that a credit has previously been granted. Secondary 4 and 5 subjects that require MELS uniform examinations have been assigned a *temporary* final result. **The FINAL result and assignment of credits will be sent through an official transcript by MELS at the beginning of July.**
