Where do I take the exam?

- 2 Mbps high speed connection.

Purpose and Eligibility

Grade 6, Secondary 1,2 & 3

- For students who have failed a course with a grade of between 50-60%.
- For students who are at risk in the development of competencies in an offered course.

Students receive a competency report upon completion of a summer school course and a student's placement for the following year may be modified if the required competency level is achieved.

Note: Students from Secondary 1-3 cannot have a mark lower than 50% to register.

Secondary 4 & 5

- For students who have failed a course and need to obtain missing credits in order to graduate.
- For students who have between 50 - 60% and wish to improve their final mark.

Students will receive a final evaluation of competencies and/or a final exam will be available. Credits are granted upon successful completion of these exams.

Note: A student must demonstrate he/she has taken the course previously.
