Exam Regulations

Medical notes will be required for absences from any exam, including the French orals.

Electronic Communication Devices

Cell phones, pagers or other electronic devices are NOT allowed in school and are NOT allowed to be brought to class during exams. These devices, if brought, must be handed to the invigilator at the start of the exam and picked up when leaving the examination room. Anyone found with an electronic device during an exam will have a mark of 0 recorded. The school will **not be responsible for missing or damaged devices** at the end of the exam. The best practice is to avoid bringing these devices into the exam room in the first place.

Duration

Students must remain in the exam for **HALF the scheduled duration** of the exam. That means that if an exam is scheduled for three hours, students **MUST** remain in the examination room for at least **one and a half hours**.

Late Arrivals

Students who arrive more than **one half hour (1/2hr) late** for an exam will NOT be admitted to the exam. Students who are late less than 30 minutes will be admitted to the exam room immediately. Late students will **NOT** be given additional time to complete the exam.

Illness during an Exam

Students who become ill during an exam **MUST** provide a medical note within 24hrs of the event.
