

5. **DRESS CODE**

Rosemere High School respects students' rights to express themselves in the way they dress. All students who attend Rosemere High School are also expected to respect the school community by dressing appropriately for an educational environment. This policy is intended to provide guidance for students, staff, and parents.

It is expected that student dress be neat and clean so that each student may share in promoting a positive, respectful, healthy, and safe atmosphere.

Student dress will be the responsibility of the student and of the parents, within the following guidelines:

- All students must wear shoes, boots or other types of footwear.
- Pajamas and house slippers are not appropriate for wear at school unless they are a part of a school sponsored activity.
- Ripped clothing (top or bottom) is not permitted.



- Articles of clothing with insignias or slogans that are disruptive to the educational process are not permitted. This includes clothing and accessories that display information about alcohol, drugs, profanity, violence, or sexually suggestive slogans or drawings.
- Students may wear hats and hoods in school, but have to remove them if requested by their classroom teacher.
- Students should comply respectfully to any request by a staff member involving the dress code. When, in the judgment of administration, a student's appearance or mode of dress is considered inappropriate, the student will be required to change before attending any classes. Appropriate clothing may be provided by the school.
- Students who do not adhere to these guidelines will be disciplined according to the Code of Conduct.
