3.0 BUSINESS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

3.1 PGB Information

L. Chartier reported on a meeting held in December, at which time the subject-time allocation was presented and deeds of establishment were discussed. After this meeting, the two new principals were appointed in January. The next meeting was held on February 3rd; members want the PGB structure to be like a governing board, even though there are no provisions in the Education Act, so there will be a Chairperson, a Secretary and minutes will be taken. The 'excellence' programmes were discussed at length, including their content, what is the criteria to be admitted, why are there now entrance exams, what is the pass mark for these exams, who will be accepted into the programmes, why is there a substantial raise in fees, etc. All of this should have gone to the Council of Commissioners first, but did not. A "to do" list for PGBs was given out and will be circulated to GB members; it includes a school logo, dress code, budget-building, etc.

- Sock project with Reliable Hosiery Company: one student per class will be chosen will do community service on a Saturday and on one school day;

- Course selection forms for Secondary 1 to be distributed tomorrow;
