At Hillcrest Academy, we offer the curriculum as outlined by the Québec Education Program.

We are a bilingual school that follows a one-week English, one-week French schedule.

Instruction is 51% English and 49% French in K4 as well as grades one through six. K5 is 80% French. Mathematics, however, is taught in English on both weeks.
