Parental Involvement

Governing Board

The Governing Board is a decision-making body that is recognized by the Education Act and the MEES. This committee is comprised of parents, teachers and support staff. Members are elected by their peers each September at the school's General Assembly and serve a two-year term.

Parent Participation Organization (PPO) The Friends of McCaig Elementary (TFOMES)

The PPO is a committee recognized by the Education Act and the MEES. This committee is comprised of parents and works in cooperation with the principal and vice-principal. The mandate of the PPO is to encourage the collaboration of parents in fostering the success of the students in our school. TFOMES is responsible for fundraising which, in turn, provides our students with materials, resources and opportunities otherwise not available.





McCaig Elementary School is a **peanut- and nut-free** school. We request that parents support this policy as there are many children in the school who are severely allergic to nuts and peanut by-products. All lunches and snacks should be **peanut- and nut-free**.

Kindergarten Education

The kindergarten education program at McCaig Elementary is in line with the curriculum provided by the Ministry of Education.

Children in our kindergarten classes have daily opportunities for social interaction through circle games, partner play, learning centres and outdoor recess play.

McCaig kindergarten children also learn to feel socially included thanks to the Grade six Buddy Program. All kindergarten classes are paired with a Grade 6 class. Through this partnership, each kindergarten student develops a bond with an older student, doing activities such as paired reading and crafts.

McCaig kindergarten students explore early literacy through Jolly Phonics, a systematic kinesthetic sound program. They also develop beginning reading skills through story time, sound awareness games and home-reading. As well, beginning writing is encouraged through printing and journal writing.

McCaig kindergarten students develop numeracy and math skills. Through seatwork, math games and math centres, students are exposed to patternmaking, sequencing and even beginning measurement.

Students are introduced to French 150 minutes a week. French vocabulary is acquired through stories, art and songs.

Students in kindergarten have physical education for 60 minutes a week.

Many fun activities are planned each year at McCaig in kindergarten. Special theme days such as Pajama Day, Celebrating Our 100th Day of School and Kindergarten Graduation are highlights of the year.
