3.0 Renovation Project - Elevator - LSA

The Council entered into discussion and the Director of Material Resources and Transportation answered questions and concerns as follows:

 The Ministère de l'Éducation et de l'enseignement supérieur (the "MEES") has requested that the cost of the elevator project be a part of the 2020-2021 maintenance budget;

Commissioner Anick Brunet entered the meeting via telephone.

Commissioners discussed:

- The lack of bidders on the project;
- That there is no other mechanism besides the SEAO for tendering;
- The need for a new tendering mechanism;

Commissioner Melissa Wall entered the meeting via telephone.

- Understanding of the need to have to follow the current systems in place;
 The fact that the Director of Material Resources and Transportation was able to negotiate

a reduction rather than having to scrap the entire tender and begin anew.

In response to questions from Commissioner Guy Gagnon, the Director of Material Resources and Transportation noted that alternate arrangements have been made for the students who use the elevator. The delivery of the project, if approved today, will be for September 2020 but if approved any later, delivery will be April 2021.

Renovation Project Elevator - LSA WHEREAS the elevator at Laval Senior Academy has ceased functioning and requires replacement;

WHEREAS the Ministère de l'Éducation et de l'Enseignement supérieur (MEES) has adopted measure 50621 to assist school boards with the repair, maintenance and renovation of its buildings;

WHEREAS public tenders for the above mentioned project were called and opened on January 14, 2020;

WHEREAS the conformability of all bidders has been verified;

WHEREAS the lowest conformable bidder submitted a price at \$798 099.00 before taxes, which was 66.8% above the estimate provided by the architectural firm;

WHEREAS there was only one bidder for the above mentioned project, allowing the school board to negotiate the price submitted;

WHEREAS the biggest discrepancy in the estimate and price submitted was the cost of the elevator and the constraints on the working hours;

WHEREAS the negotiation process allowed for a reduction in the cost of the project by \$165 222.00;

Commissioner Bob Pellerin MOVED THAT, on the recommendation of the Director of Material Resources and Transportation, the Council of Commissioners of the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board award the contract for the above mentioned project to **Roland Grenier Construction Inc.** for a total cost of \$632 877.00 before taxes or \$676 461.66 net taxes;

AND THAT the Chairperson, or in their absence or with their knowledge the Vice-Chair, as well as the Director General, or in their absence or with their knowledge the Assistant Director General, be authorized to sign all documentation concerning this project;

FURTHER THAT, the Director of Material Resources and Transportation, be authorized to sign documentation concerning this project, as per By-Law no BL2008-CA-01: Delegation of Functions & Powers of the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board.

The Assistant Director of Human Resources provided background information on the candidate selected noting that the recommendation was a unanimous decision by the Selection Committee.
