According to the Education Act, Sections 185: "Every school board shall establish an advisory committee on services for handicapped students and students with social maladjustments or learning disabilities."

The Special Education Advisory Committee (SEAC) of the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board is composed of:

- Parents of students concerned Teachers Non-teaching professional staff Support staff
- A school principal The Director General or his/her representative

The role of this committee is to:

- Advise the school board on a policy for the organization of educational services for students with special education learning needs
- Advise on the allocation of financial resources to the services intended for these students

The committee may also advise on the implementation of an IEP.

While SEAC does not deal with individual issues, parents of children with special needs are welcome to attend the meetings.
