Fibre Optic Partnership WHEREAS the Council of Commissioners of the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board (SWLSB) adopted resolution no. 990922-IT-0034, entering into a partnership with the Commission scolaire de Laval (CS de Laval) and the Commission scolaire des Affluents for the construction of a fibre-optic network;

WHEREAS the fibre-optic network was constructed by Telus and the initial twenty years of network maintenance fees were included in the construction costs;

WHEREAS the CS de Laval, as the representative of the partners, revised the agreement with Telus in 2010 to extend the network no-maintenance fees until August 31, 2021;

WHEREAS the Centre de services scolaire de Laval (CSS de Laval), formerly CS de Laval, has negotiated a new five-year agreement for network maintenance fees;

WHEREAS this new agreement covers all work required for keeping the infrastructure in good working order, such as upgrading equipment, relocating cable and repairing damage, thereby ensuring the longevity of the investment;

WHEREAS the CSS de Laval has negotiated a reduced network maintenance fee of \$175.00 per kilometre;

WHEREAS the total annual cost to the SWLSB will be of approximately \$16,000.00, before taxes;

Commissioner Bob Pellerin MOVED THAT, on the recommendation of the Advisory Committee – Student Success, the Council of Commissioners of the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board authorize the Director of Information Resources to renew the fibre-optic partnership with the Centre de services scolaire de Laval, as per document no.
