## The Council adopted the following resolutions:

Authorization for Consultation	WHEREAS section 275 of the <i>Education Act</i> requires a school board to establish the objectives and principles governing the allocation of its revenues;
CC-221214-FR-0061	WHEREAS the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board has drafted its 2023-2024 Budget Consultation Survey;
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WHEREAS said survey was presented to the Audit Committee on December 7, 2022, as well as to the Resource Allocation Committee on November 22, 2022;
