At Terry Fox, we offer the curriculum outlined by the Québec Education Program at all levels:

K4 and K5 I 3 days English, 2 days French

(including éducation physique)

The pre-kindergarten and kindergarten education programs at Terry Fox are in line with the curriculums provided by the Ministère de l'Éducation. Children in our K4 and K5 classes have daily opportunities for social interaction, guided learning, exploration of early literacy, physical activity, introduction to French as a second language and cooperative play.
