The Council adopted the following resolutions:

Appointment of In-School Administrators WHEREAS the positions of Vice-Principal at Laurentian Regional High School, Laval Senior Academy and Rosemère High School are currently vacant;

2024-2025 Initial Budget

CC-240925-FR-0004

WHEREAS in accordance with the *Education Act* (R.S.Q., Chapter I-13.1), the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board must adopt and submit to the Minister of Education its operating, investment and debt service budget for the 2024-2025 school year;

WHEREAS this budget is balanced for the 2024-2025 school year;

WHEREAS the school tax proceeds, which were of \$10,890,601, were determined by taking into account:

- an adjusted standardized assessment of taxable immovables of \$25,000 or less in the amount of \$26,023,518;
- an amount of 24,605 taxable immovables of more than \$25,000; and
- the rate of \$0.09152 per \$100 of the assessment set by the Minister for the 2024-2025 school tax;

Commissioner Stéphane Henley MOVED THAT the operating, investment and debt service budget, providing for revenues of \$239,352,119 and expenses of \$239,352,119 be approved and submitted to the Minister of Education.

Revenu Québec My Account for Businesses WHEREAS the school board is required to name someone to oversee its Revenu Québec "My Account for Businesses";

Commissioner Barbara Barrasso MOVED THAT, on the recommendation of the Director General, the Council of Commissioners of the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board name Daniel Harvey, Director of Financial Resources, as the person responsible for the Revenu Québec's *My Account for Businesses* dossier for the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board;

AND THAT authorization be given to the Director of Financial Resources to:

- register the business with Revenu Québec;
- manage the business's registration for clicSÉQUR Entreprises;
- manage the business's registration for My Account for businesses (and anything else this entails);
- take on the role and responsibilities of the person in charge of using the online services described in My Account for businesses conditions for use (for example, by granting powers of attorney and authorizations to the business's users and to other businesses);
- view the business's file and act on behalf of the business for all periods and taxation years (past, present, and future), including participating in any negotiations with Revenu Québec involving any information Revenu Québec holds about the business for the administration and enforcement of tax legislation, the Excise Tax Act and the Act to facilitate the payment of support, by communicating with Revenu Québec over the phone, in person, in writing or through online services;

FURTHER THAT the Chairperson, as well as the Director General, and in their absence or with their knowledge the Assistant Director General, be authorized to sign all documentation concerning *My Account for Businesses*.

WHEREAS public call for tenders no. 24-205-01 was published for the acquisition of a generator for the Administrative Center, including the rental of a temporary mobile generator, and the bids were opened on September 12, 2024;

WHEREAS the conformity of all bidders has been verified;

Commissioner Anik Brunet MOVED THAT, on the recommendation of the Director of Material Resources and Transportation, the Council of Commissioners of the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board award the contract for the acquisition of a generator for the Administrative Center, including the rental of a temporary mobile generator to Systèmes urbains inc., for a total cost of \$504,620.00 before taxes, or \$539,371.92 net taxes;

AND THAT the engagement above be conditional to the receipt of all contractual documents;

FURTHER THAT the Director of Material Resources and Transportation be authorized to sign all documentation concerning this project.
