As outlined in the OPQ "Guidelines for the Assessment of a Child in Connection with a Request for Derogation to the Age of School Admission," kindly provide us with the following information:

- Data with respect to the child's functioning in the following spheres: intellectual, social, emotional, and psychomotor;
- <u>A statement determining serious prejudice</u>: demonstrate how the absence of early school admission would impede the child's harmonious development by documenting the likely negative effects of such a situation; OR
- <u>A statement determining negative impact</u>: demonstrate how early school admission risks harming the child.

Please be sure to also provide us with standard scores for all scales of the intelligence test and standard scores for all other psychometric tests administered.
