Exciting News! CDC Pont-Viau is thrilled to announce that the Ministry of Education has granted us the right to offer our **Sustainable Homes in Quebec** training in English! This course is officially recognized as a specialized program for licensed professionals responsible for construction work in the following categories: Construction Techniques – Specialization: Sustainable Development

STUDENT-LED INTITIATIVES

CDC Lachute students are currently working on an OSEntreprendre initiative called Period Poverty. Their goal is to debunk common menstrual myths and shed light on a critical reality: 25% of girls and women in Canada cannot afford menstrual products. If their grant application is successful, they plan to use the funds to purchase menstrual products for the centre, helping ensure greater accessibility for all.



HEALTH AND WELLNESS IN AEVT! A.C.T. / CISSS GRANT FOR \$10 000.00



CDC Pont-Viau is proud to announce that we have received an additional \$10,000 grant from the CISSS de Laval in conjunction with Adult Collaboration Team (ACT) to create student "Chill Zones"—welcoming spaces designed to support relaxation, social connection, and emotional well-being. With limited physical space and few nearby amenities, these zones will offer students comfortable areas to recharge between classes, including quiet corners, cozy seating, phone-charging stations, and even a foosball table for fun and stress relief. This project was inspired directly by student and teacher feedback, through written and video testimonials highlighting the need for dedicated spaces to unwind, reconnect, and maintain balance throughout the day.

NEW INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITIES FOR CDC PONT-VIAU STUDENTS!



We are thrilled to announce that the Public Service Commission of Canada has officially added the CDC Pont-Viau to its database for potential internship opportunities! Business Training Services continues to innovate and launch new training opportunities to meet the needs of companies. While most of our training programs are delivered in French, English sessions can be arranged upon request.


